

School Budget Process Overview

- District Funding Sources: 72% State, 15% local taxes, 9% other (grants, interest income), 4% federal
- State Fiscal year is July-July; District is Sept-August
- During the Jan-May legislative session in Olympia, funds are determined for the following year using the "prototypical schools" funding model to determine the majority of money allocated to the district
- Various bills can also result in more money for the district, or more unfunded mandates.

School Budget Process Overview

- The district develops a budget in Jan-March
- Enrollment and known mandatory expenses as a base. Modified with enrollment numbers in March, and final enrollment in September.
- If there will be a budget shortfall, cuts are recommended during March-May.
- ESD budget for 23-24 is approx. \$394 Million 87% is staffing.
- January 2024 \$16M shortfall was reduced to \$10M in March (2.5% of TTL Budget).
- Due to restricted funding and mandates, many categories cannot be cut; electives are vulnerable.
- Due to the union's requirements on RIF notices, the current PLAN to cut staff must be announced by the May 15th deadline. (voted on next week, 4/23 board meeting)
- District budget is voted on in July, changes can happen, including bringing back RIF'd staff until Sept.


